REFLECTION

Today's liturgy invites us to conversion. In the first reading, Prophet Isaiah prompts us to be converted and to live a life of righteousness and meekness. St. John the Baptist through his life and message, invites us to repent and to welcome Jesus Christ. Jesus came 2022 years ago as baby in Bethlehem. The same Jesus comes and keeps coming today, but we often fail to recognize him. Because we do not know how to perceive his presence in every event of our life. In fact, we are afraid to welcome Christ because we are worried if his message would upset us by demanding a radical transformation of our habits/lives. So, we rather prefer to keep our eyes and ears closed.

There is a great need for the coming of Jesus today! He needs to come into the lives of people who have closed the doors of love, compassion, and mercy. He needs to come to the families, and communities, whose members are envious, jealous, divided, speak ill of each other, do not help each other. He needs to come to the nations and countries where citizens kill each other, where there is war, violence, injustice, hate grudges and so on. However, he cannot come and will not come unless we remove the obstacles that prevent his coming. Barriers will have to be pulled down, valleys filled up and people must love one another, and they must remain united. Let God help us to live his commandment: "Love one another as I have loved you".
