Gospel Reflection

This Sunday the Church is celebrating the feast of the Ascension of the Lord. The Feast of the Ascension is the Lord's going back home to His Father after the completion of the work entrusted to Him, the Son of God, by his Heavenly Father. It took place on the Mount of Olives in the presence of the disciples. This helped the disciples to understand the crucifixion and death in a new light. So, the departure of the Lord did not make them sad, rather they were filled with great joy. And they expressed it by spending their time in the temple all the time praising and rendering thanks. The Lord has done what he was meant to do. What matters now is that the disciples must continue the work that he inaugurated. So, just before his Ascension into heaven, the risen Lord asked the disciples to go into the whole world proclaiming the good news and making everyone his followers by baptizing them. The Apostles did as their Master commanded them. Now it is our turn. We are called to proclaim the good news and preach that same forgiveness and repentance that Jesus brought from God. Today let us ask the Lord to open our minds as he did for his apostles during the Ascension so that we may understand the mysteries of our salvation; that we may share the good news with our world which is still waiting to know him and be liberated. Lord, fill our hearts with your Spirit so that we may have the courage to bear witness to you in our times.
