

Dear Parishioners,

It is to bring to your attention that due to some technical issues the Direct Deposit you have assigned/authorized to the parish as a biweekly donation was not deducted from your account from June 17, 2022. The last date on which it was deducted was the 16th of June. So the biweeklies of June 30th, July 14th, July 28th, August 11th, and August 25th had not come out from your account. But when the technical issues were rectified, the pending money was deducted on August 26, September 1st, and September 8. However, from September 22nd onwards it is regularized. I assure you that the church has not received/ taken any extra amount other than what you have authorized from your account. I had announced this in the church once. But I have come to know that it has caused lots of confusion, frustration, and inconvenience to some of the Direct Depositors. It is quite natural and I understand. I am really sorry for the inconvenience and problem it created. We will try that in the future it may not happen. And I sincerely thank each one of you for your constant support without which our parish will not survive.
